The event will feature multidisciplinary artistic programming, free of charge, from Thursday, October 15 to Sunday, October 18, 2015 at Place Émilie-Gamelin, in Montreal's Quartier des spectacles.

5 p.m. I Inauguration of ATSA's new work, *Prendre... le temps d'une soupe.*

The first guests will be greeted. A maître d' will accompany each impromptu pair to their seats, introduce them to one another, and propose a "menu" of conversation starters to break the ice and spice up their chat for the time it takes them to enjoy their bowl of soup (graciously provided by Soupesoup).

Who will have some soup with François Avard, Dominic Champagne, François Papineau, Amir Khadir, Brigitte Poupart, Josée Blanchette and many other well-known artists, on-site from 5 to 6 p.m. as they too drop by to share some soup and conversation with a perfect stranger? The installation runs continuously until 10 p.m.
